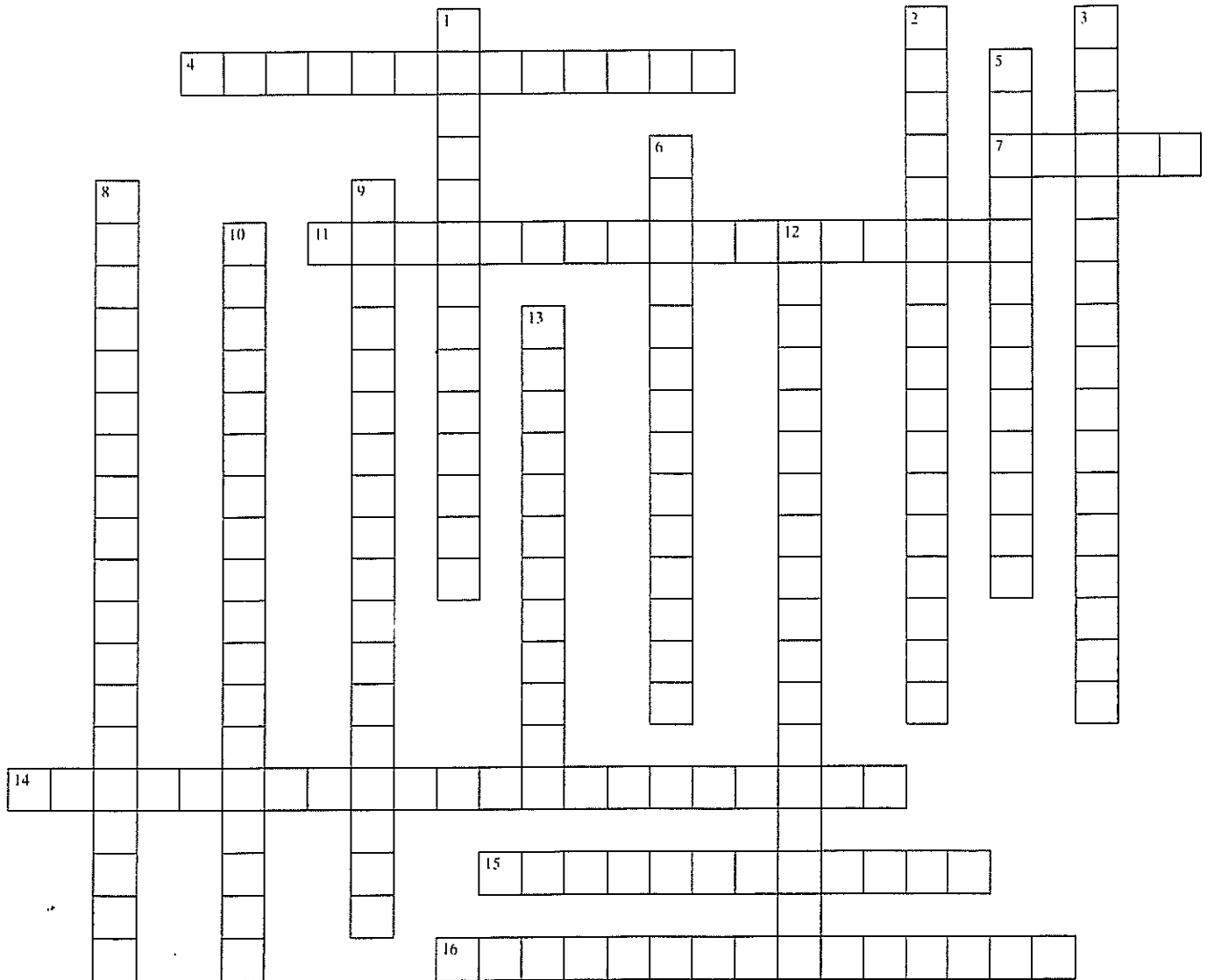

France & Germany after the Congress of Vienna



ACROSS

- 4 War between Austria & Prussia that united the German states north of Austria
- 7 Nation that joined Germany & Austria-Hungary's Dual Alliance in 1882, forging a Triple Alliance
- 11 German name for the government that replaced the German Confederation after the Seven Weeks' War
- 14 Agreement between German Empire, Austria, & Russia that stated the 3 powers would discuss any matters concerning foreign policy
- 15 Alliance formed in 1879 between Germany & Austria-Hungary; it's goal was to protect each nation from an attack from Russia
- 16 Named chancellor of the German Confederation in 1862; he was largely responsible for establishing a long-standing alliance between Germany & Austria, which forced the Austrians to remain in a subordinate role

DOWN

- 1 French government established in 1848 when Louis Napoleon Bonaparte was elected President of France
- 2 Agreement signed by Germany & Russia in 1887 where each nation agreed to support each other militarily in the event of a French attack on Germany OR in the event of an Austrian attack on Russia
- 3 Treaty that ended the Franco-Prussian war
- 5 Democratic government in France that was created after the Franco-Prussian War by the new French National Assembly
- 6 French territory lost to Germany as a result of the Franco-Prussian War, which left the French thirsting for revenge against the Germans
- 8 Loose association, created by the Congress of Vienna, of 39 German-speaking states
- 9 Period of time in France, after the Congress of Vienna, when two brothers of Louis XVI ruled
- 10 French term for the three glorious days that resulted in Louis-Phillipe replacing Charles X as king of France
- 12 Title Louis Napoleon took in 1852, signifying the start of the 2nd French Empire
- 13 New government formed one month after the end of the Franco-Prussian War
